



Road Ban Information

The Town of Fox Creek will be placing a **75% Road Ban on 3rd Street East** (Iosegun Lake Road). This Road Ban will be in effect March 20, 2019 to mid-June 2019.

Information pertaining to Road Ban Exemptions

Road Ban Exemption Permits Cost:	Local Business with a valid business license	\$100.00 per Trip
	Non-local businesses	\$500.00 per Trip

Note: These exemption permits are for a single one way trip only. They will need a physical permit, before they can travel, as per bylaw 806-2018 Traffic Bylaw.

Road Use Agreement Exemption:

A company that has a **ROAD USE AGREEMENT** (RUA) with the Town is exempt from a Road Ban under these conditions.

1. They do not exceed the legal axle weights and gross vehicle weights under the Commercial Vehicle Weights and Dimension Act/Regulations on a local road unless they have a Municipal TAC Permit.
2. They have self-reported or paid for their Haul Permit under the RUA before operating on a Road Ban.
3. If they exceed the legal load limits and are over-weight, they will still need to purchase the **Road Ban Exemption Permit** from the Town of Fox Creek and a **TRAVIS PERMIT** from Alberta Transportation before they can operate on a Road Ban.

How can a company get a Road Ban Exemption Permit?

Please email permits@foxcreek.ca and request a Road Ban Exemption Permit with the following information:

1. Your RUA Number (if applicable).
2. Your company name, address and phone number
3. Your Motor Vehicle Identification Number (MVID).
4. Provide the date you will be requiring the permit for.
5. Provide information on what you are hauling.

These Road Bans are in place to protect the Town's roadway infrastructure due to spring thaw. A municipality has the authority to place road bans on any road they choose.
