Fox Creek RCMP's impaired driving initiative resulted in **14** impaired drivers being taken off the road with Immediate Roadside Sanctions being issued. In addition to the impaired driving sanctions, over **140** traffic tickets and traffic warnings were also issued over the previous four weeks.

Impaired driving continues to be the leading cause of vehicle collisions and presents a significant road safety concern.

Impaired driving carries significant penal-

ties and can include fines, vehicle impound, license suspensions and potential criminal charges.




