



We will try to keep the disruption minimal. Please ensure the cold water is clear before doing laundry.

Also beginning May 8, crews will be line and crosswalk intersection painting. In addition the pothole crew, equipment and the sweeper will make the rounds, as necessary, throughout the summer.

As usual, exercise caution and attentiveness when traveling near road crews.

- 1 ton truck and under: \$5.00

- 1-3 ton truck: \$250.00
- Tandem: \$500.00
- End Dump: \$750.00
- Hydrovac (clean materials with no contaminates only): \$150.00/load
- Car/Truck Bodies: \$100.00 each

Wednesday, Friday and Saturday 08:00 am – 4:00 pm (year round) Tuesday and Thursday 11:00 am – 7:00 pm (May to September) Tuesday and Thursday 08:00 am – 4:00 pm (October to April) Located on Airport Road, the Transfer Site accepts transferable or smaller recyclable items such as domestic garbage, electronics, paint, grass and leaves, batteries, florescent light bulbs, fridges and freezers, tires and clean fill.
